

Mary Lou Hale's School of Dance – Dress Code 2011-12

ABSolute Body Sculpting – Comfortable Workout Attire and Sneakers.

Ballet/Tumbling Combo - Hair up and away from the face, Leotard, Tights, Skirt Optional, and Pink Leather Ballet Shoes (no satin bedroom slippers).

Ballet & Contemporary – Hair up and away from the face, Leotard, Skirt Optional, Pink Tights, and Pink Leather Ballet Shoes. Black tight fitting boy shorts and/or tan booties may be put on for the contemporary portion of class.

Hip Hop – Hair up and away from the face, Leotard or Tight Fitting Dance Top (no baggy or graphic t-shirts or sweatshirts), Black Dance Pants or Capris (no shorts, jeans, sweatpants, or pajama bottoms), Black Knee Pads, and Black Hip Hop Sneakers (no street shoes).

Jazz/Ballet Combo – Hair up and away from the face, Leotard, Skirt Optional, Tights, and Pink Leather Ballet Shoes (no satin bedroom slippers).

Jazz/Gymnastics Combo – Hair up and away from the face, Leotard (no t-shirts or sweatshirts), Black Boy Shorts Optional (no pants or skirts please), Tights optional, and White Slip On Jazz/Gym Shoes.

Jazz/Hip Hop Combo – Hair up and away from the face, Leotard or Tight Fitting Dance Top (no baggy or graphic t-shirts or sweatshirts), Black Tight Fitting Dance Pants or Capris (no shorts, jeans, baggy pants, sweatpants, or pajama bottoms), Black Knee Pads, and Black Jazz Shoes, Booties, or Hip Hop Sneakers.

Jazz - Hair up and away from the face, Leotard or Tight Fitting Dance Top (no baggy or graphic t-shirts or sweatshirts), Black Tight Fitting Dance Pants, Capris, or Boy Shorts (no jeans, baggy pants, sweatpants, or pajama bottoms), and Black (Tan for High School Class) Jazz Shoes or Booties (no hip hop sneakers).

Musical Theater – Hair up and away from the face, Leotard or Tight Fitting Dance Top (no baggy or graphic t-shirts or sweatshirts), Black Tight Fitting Dance Pants or Capris (no shorts, jeans, baggy pants, sweatpants, or pajama bottoms), Grades 4&5 and Adults: Black Jazz Shoes or Booties...Middle School: Tan Booties...High School: Tan Booties and Tan Character Shoes With Rubber Bottoms.

Tap/Ballet Combo – Hair up and away from the face, Leotard, Tights, Skirt Optional, White Tap Shoes, and Pink Leather Ballet Shoes (no satin bedroom slippers).

Tap/Ballet/Tumble Combo - Hair up and away from the face, Leotard, Tights, Skirt Optional, White Tap Shoes, and Pink Leather Ballet Shoes (no satin bedroom slippers).

Tap/Jazz Combo – Hair up and away from the face, Leotard or Tight Fitting Dance Top (no baggy or graphic t-shirts or sweatshirts), Tights, Skirt Optional, Black Tight Fitting Dance Pants or Capris Optional. White Tap Shoes and White Jazz Shoes (either lace up or slip on).

Tap – Hair up and away from the face, Leotard or Tight Fitting Dance Top (no baggy or graphic t-shirts or sweatshirts), Black Tight Fitting Dance Pants or Capris (no shorts, jeans, baggy pants, sweatpants, or pajama bottoms), and Black Tap Shoes.

Zumba – Comfortable Workout Attire, Jingle Scarf Optional, and Sneakers.

Male Attire – Generally, male dancers wear track pants or knee length athletic shorts (no jeans) and a solid color t-shirt. Shoes for most male dancers are black (depending on the class). Please see Miss Karen for your class' requirements.
